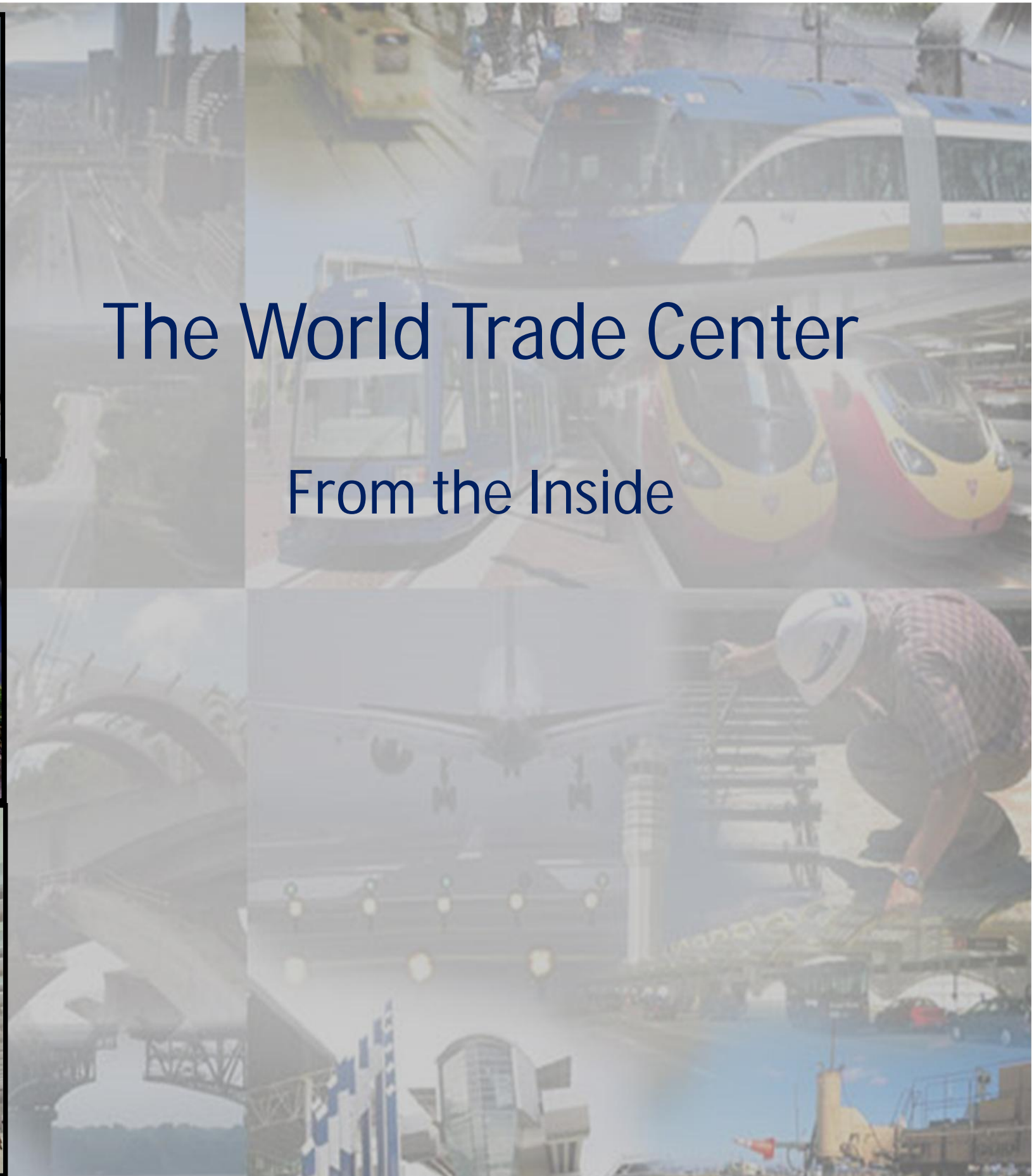

Workers have begun to install the approximately 12,000 glass facade panels that will cover the 104-story One World Trade Center.



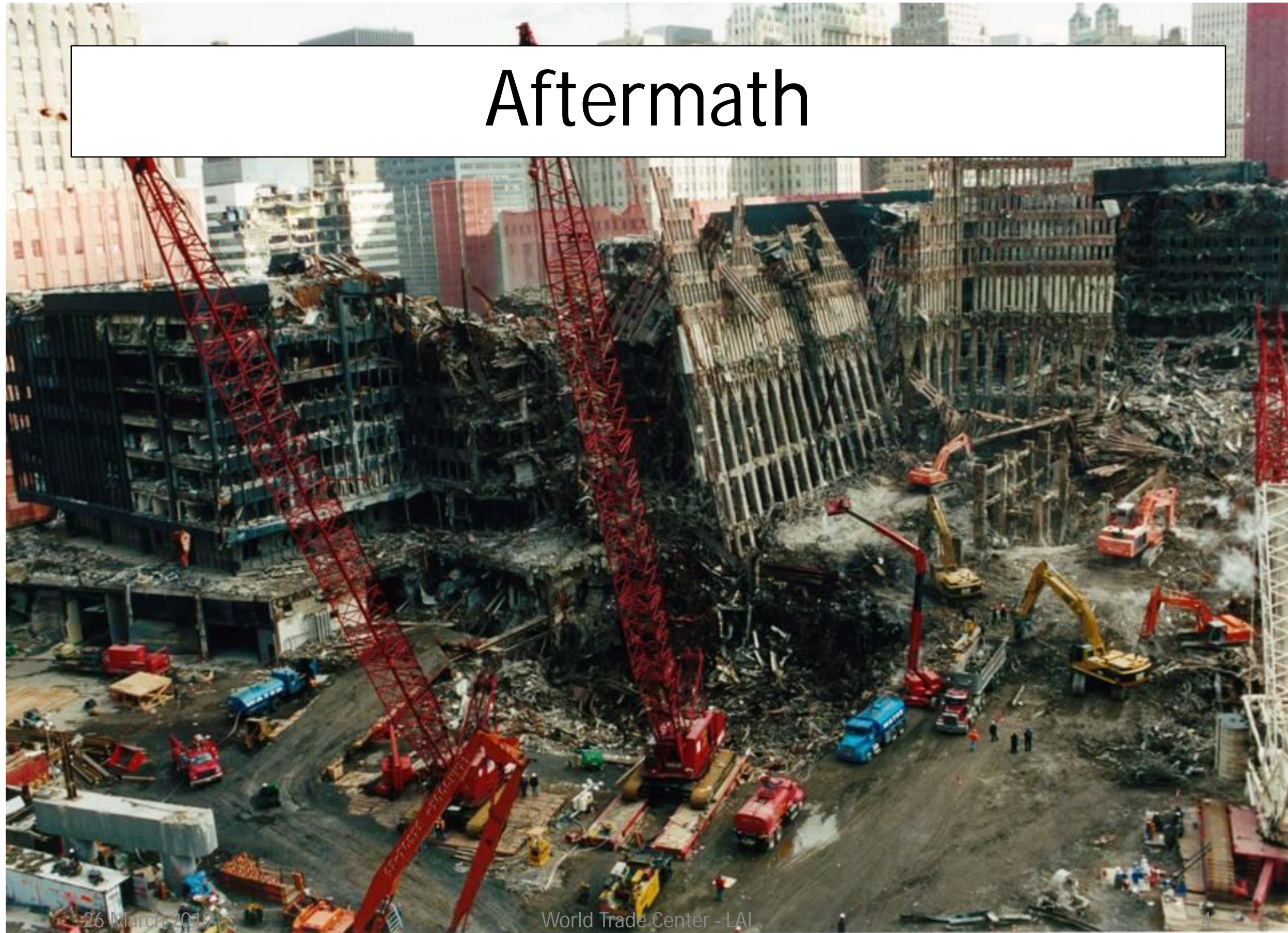

Transportation Hub The Oculus

- Between Towers 2 & 3
- 800,000 SF
- 250,000 pedestrians per day
- Multi-story central transit hall
 - lower concourse
 - upper (balcony) concourse
 - public waiting area
 - first-class retail amenities (200,000 SF)
- Enhanced permanent PATH facilities & services
- Integrated network of underground pedestrian connections

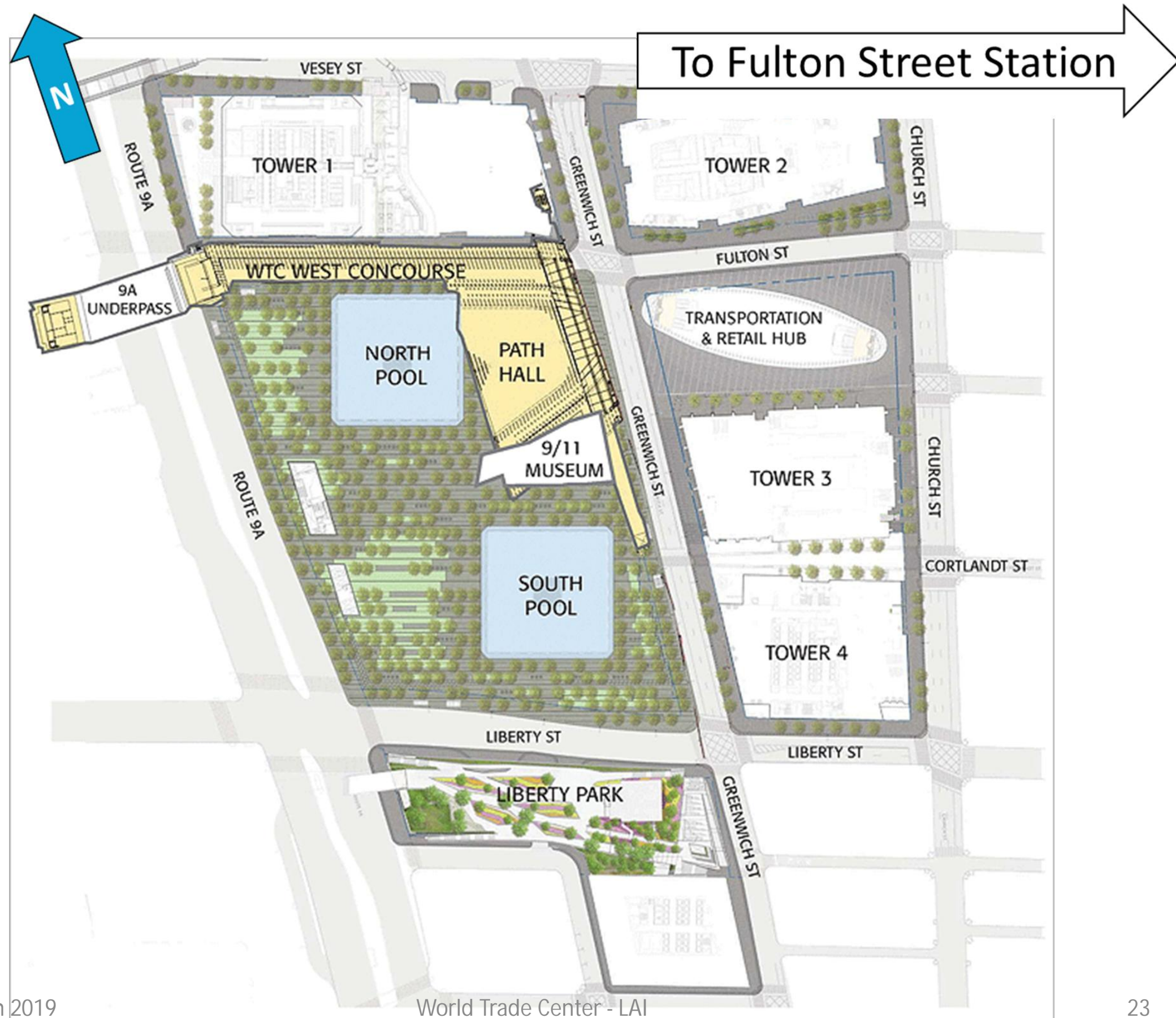

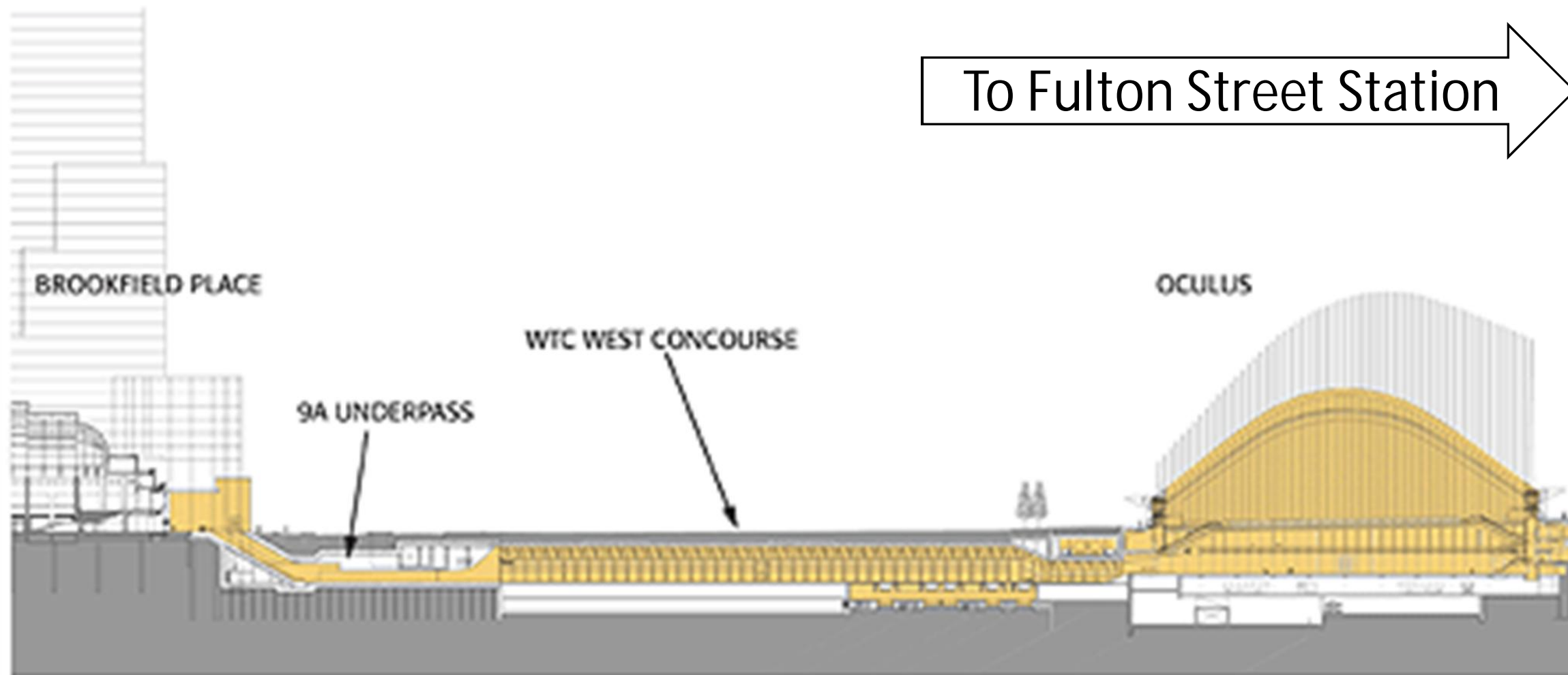

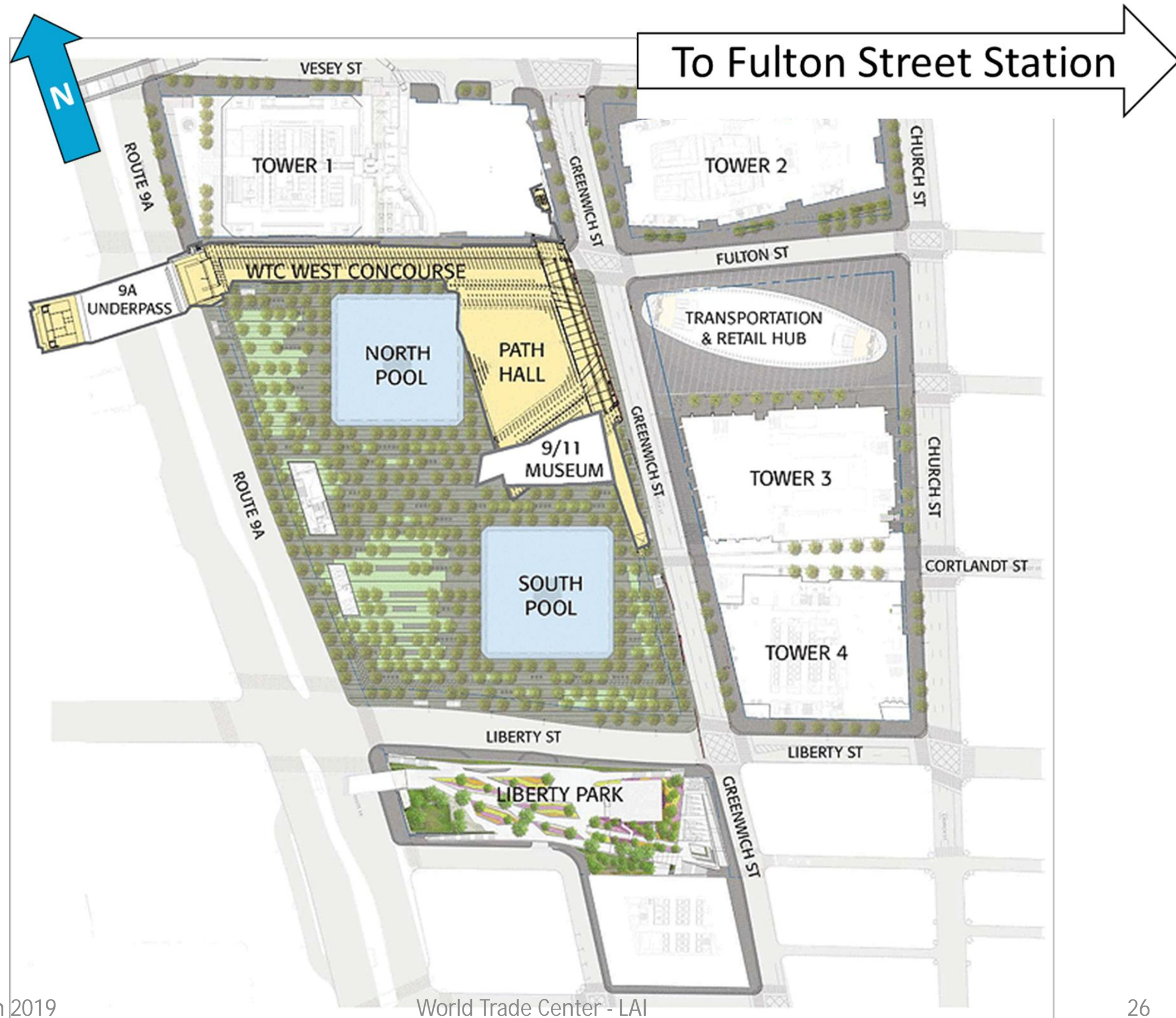

- Retail Complex
- 500,000 SF
- Six levels
 - Two-levels below-grade concourse
 - World Financial Center to Fulton Street Transit Center
 - Below-grade Transportation Hub
 - Street level
 - Church Street, Cortlandt Way, Dey Street
 - Three-levels
 - Office towers



Memorial & Museum

- Two massive pools (nearly 1 acre each)
- Names inscribed edges of pools
- Eight-acre landscaped plaza (300+ trees)
- Museum below grade

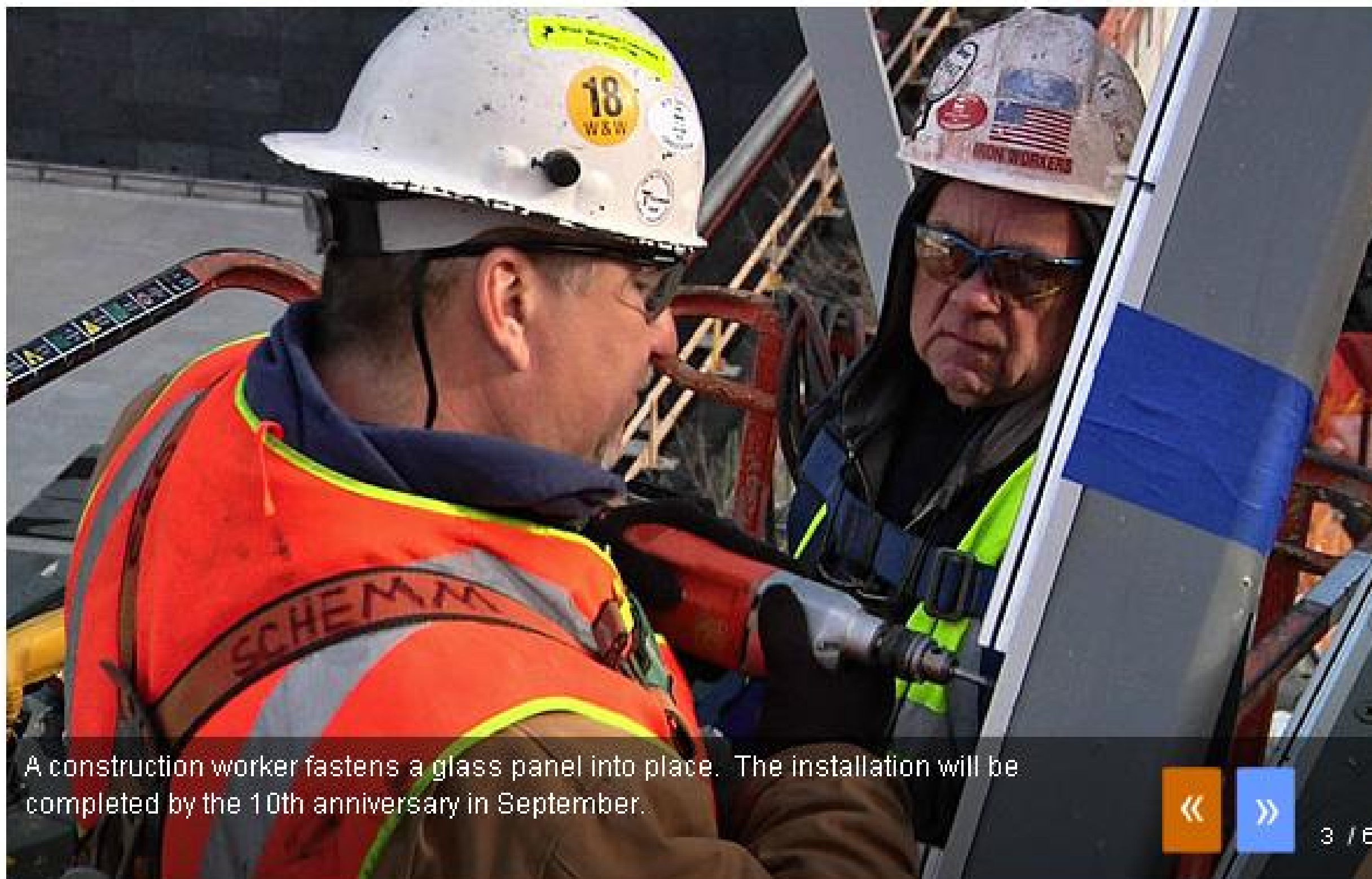
